A few of my ribs are showing


I am standing or lying outside in a lot of mud or in bad weather

If I get a bad injury or sickness, someone provides care


There are a few cracks and chips at the edges of my hooves


I am the only horse in my pasture, I neigh sometimes, and there are flies














## I NEED HELP!

My owner does not live nearby and you are sure I am not checked on daily
